APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS (LOCAL / INTERNATIONAL)

1. Enclosed are:
 - a) Application form
 - b) Form for Referee's Report
2. The application form must be completed in English; and supporting documents, if not in English, must be accompanied by copies of the English translation of the documents.
3. At least one Referee's Report from your current Head of Department or Supervisor is to be submitted by using the attached Referee's Report form. The other Referee's Report may be from other sources. The referees may send to us the Referee's Report form directly, or enclosed in your application in an sealed envelope.
4. Applicants who wish to be considered for Graduate Scholarships should ensure that this is clearly indicated in Section F (2). Please note that the Scholarships will cover tuition fees, travel and book allowances. You will need to obtain separate funding for accommodation, personal and other living expenses.
5. As the medium of instruction is English, applicants whose native language or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English should submit **TOEFL/IELTS** scores as evidence of their proficiency in the English language. Applicants must obtain a minimum TOEFL score of 580 (paper based) or 237 (computer based) or IELTS score of 6.
6. Please note that **Certified True copies/Notarised copies** of all the relevant documents must be submitted upon application. Original documents must be produced for verification upon request. Documents submitted in support of application will not be returned to applicants. Applicants who fail to present their original documents for verification without acceptable reasons will be deemed to have withdrawn their application.
7. Please arrange the application documents in the following order:
 - a) Application Form (duly completed) and 2 recent passport-sized photographs
 - b) Certified True Copy / Notarized Copy of Certificates & Transcripts for the qualifications stated in the application form
 - c) Certified True Copy of SMC Registration Certificate, if applicable
 - d) Certified True Copy / Notarized Copy of TOEFL / IELTS Scoresheet (for applicants whose native tongue or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English)
 - e) Documentary proof of financial support (E.g. letter of sponsorship) if applicable.
 - f) Other supporting documents (photocopies of NRIC / Passport, membership of organisations etc)
 - g) Application Fee of **Singapore \$53.50** by either cash / cheque / bankdraft payable to the 'National University of Singapore'. Please note that only application accompanied by the application fee will be considered.
