The candidate has to be a team player who is able to work across disciplinary fields; and will be expected to use their own initiative to develop the Centre's research programme.

The selected candidate will contribute to a number of current research projects. Opportunities for developing the candidate's own research will also be given, since this is a non-tenured academic appointment under the Research Track.
