

**A/P Voon Chee Tet, Francis has been awarded the title of Honorary Fellow with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021**

With over 40 years of teaching experience under his wing, A/P Voon has made a considerable impact to the university and the Department of Anatomy with his dedication to the department's pedagogical initiatives. He has taught gross anatomy and histology lessons as well as various medical, dental, pharmacy and life sciences modules for first, second and third-year students. Over the years, he has also assisted with the coordination of several core modules in the department as well as postgraduate modules in various clinical fields.

A/P Voon excelled in pedagogical research and is a pioneer in exploring technology-enhanced learning. He has taken a great interest in the usage of various technological tools to develop and produce learning materials aimed at enhancing the delivery of medical content in his classes. He has won several teaching awards including NUS Medicine Faculty Teaching Excellence Awards (2005, 2009), NUS Medicine Special recognition awards (2016-2020), and Faculty of Dentistry Teaching Excellence Award (2009). He was also placed in NUS 100 Best Teachers List for 2002-2003.

A/P Voon actively helped the department with many curriculum-related administrative duties such as chairing the Examination Committees that supervised and vetted all examination content and questions for Medical, Dental, Pharmacy and Life Sciences examinations. He also assisted the Student Affairs Unit in NUS Medicine Deanery in helping medical students and doctors at NUHS with Cognitive Behavioral Psychotherapy for issues which were affecting their studies and work. In addition to this, A/P Voon was seconded to the NUS Administration from 1995 to 1997 as a Special Assistant to Vice-Chancellor, Professor Lim Pin in conceptualizing and developing the New Modular System to be used across NUS.
