Ioannis Bakolis is a Professor of Public Mental Health and Statistics and founding Deputy Director of the Centre for Mental Health Policy and Evaluation at King's College London. Prof. Bakolis programme of multi-disciplinary research aims to inform public health policy and clinical decision making on how climate and environmental stressors and other forms of social adversity affect population mental and physical health.

Ioannis is an international expert on how to best design, evaluate, implement, and scale up population-health interventions and nation-wide policies worldwide. His research has received over £30million of funding and has been disseminated in over 170 publications to-date.

Nick Sevdalis is the Academic Director of the Centre for Behavioural & Implementation Science Interventions and a Visiting Professor at the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine of NUS (2023-). He also serves as Chief Editor of the Journal Frontiers in Health Services, Implementation Science (2021-). Nick previously held several academic roles at King's College London (2015-23) and at the Patient Safety Translational Research Centre of Imperial College London (2004-15).

Nick's vision is to achieve population health and high-quality healthcare delivery through application of behavioural sciences and partnership development between stakeholders in academia, health services and industry. His research is situated within the interdisciplinary space of implementation science and applied psychology and has been disseminated in over 450 publications to-date.
