Prof. G.J. Melendez-Torres is Professor of Clinical and Social Epidemiology at the University of Exeter, where he leads the School for Public Health Environments Research at Exeter (SPHERE), the Exeter-Cardiff-Birmingham NIHR Public Health Review Team, and co-leads the Isca Evidence synthesis group. His research spans health technology assessment, child and adolescent social development (especially in schools), and intimate partner violence. Nationally, he serves as Associate Director for Involvement and Engagement for the NIHR School for Public Health Research and Deputy Director of the Exeter NIHR Policy Research Programme Evidence Reviews Facility. Until July 2023, he led the Peninsula Technology Assessment Group (PenTAG), a major UK unit advising NICE on clinical and cost effectiveness of new drugs, and remains chief investigator on its platform grant. He also holds the citiesRISE Research Chair in Public Mental Health, leading research to promote youth mental health globally.
