PART 1 MODULES & READINGS IN CLINICAL ETHICS

- Other contextual concerns


PART 2 CASE-BASED INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP

2 half-day online sessions on 14 & 15 June 2021 (9.00am — 12.50pm)

- Format: Small group learning conducted via 700m
- Class size is limited to 35 pax (Ratio of 1 trainer to 7 participants)

What will be covered:

- Breaking bad news and collusion
- Managing family requests for information
- Issues with colleagues
- Safe discharge
