Presentation title: When 'Yes, Doctor' may not mean agreement The Informed and shared decision making in the high context culture.

Abstract

A partnership doctor-patient communication required trust, equity, and two-way exchange information. Patient-centered clinical decision making needs a partnership communication style. However, in the high context culture like Southeast Asian, there are social hierarchy and collectivistic context that challenged a partnership style of doctor-patient communication. Guides from western with lower context culture may not be suitable. So how to help our patients to receive maximum care with a more approachable communication skill?
