"Teaching Professionalism In Medicine?"

Professionalism in medicine is the bedrock doctrine of medicine that provides for an effective delivery of healthcare. It includes the concepts, values, the ethics, motivation and principles underlying the conduct of professionals and the relationships they establish for the effective delivery of healthcare.

There is no universally accepted and tested doctrine of medical professionalism. The outline of the knowledge and skills base in this area will be discussed. Probable methods of teaching professionalism would be explored.
