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### Course Description

The use of high technology medical simulators alone does not necessarily result in effective simulation learning. The challenge to faculty members is to design and develop a lesson plan that optimizes the simulation experience of participants and maximizes the use of faculty time.

This full day interactive workshop is designed to provide faculty members with practical information and skills associated with use of simulation to enhance medical/health professional education.

### Course Objectives

Participants in this workshop will learn about concepts in medical simulation, the use of debriefing and assessment in simulation training. They will work in groups to develop a lesson plan, run their simulation training session, and discuss the common pitfalls encountered.

They will also have an opportunity to share their thoughts and exchange ideas on integrating simulation learning into their existing training curriculum.
