Course Description

Small group teaching - learning has become the cornerstone of contemporary medical / health professional education.

Learning in small groups optimises deeper understanding of content knowledge, develop collaborative learning among peers as well as develop important domain-independent skills (e.g., communication, team-work) relevant for future practice.
