## **Course Description**

Videos have been used widely in health professional education. Videos have been demonstrated to support teaching and learning in many settings. To optimize learning outcomes, video use and video production should be guided by best practices and principles derived from educational technology research. We will cover best practices in using educational videos as well as strategies in producing educational video. A series of case studies will be used together with workshop participants' experience to illustrate the application of these principles. By the end of the workshop, participants will learn:

- 3. What criteria should be used to select available online videos?
- 4. How to produce your own videos?
- 5. What are the technical requirements in producing your own videos?
- 6. How to best design the video content?
