The workshop will explore contemporary best evidence practices in developing multi-station clinical assessment.

The participants will get opportunities to discuss the strengths, limitations and challenges as well as hands-on training developing these clinical skill assessments.

After this workshop participants will be able to:

- discuss the underpinning educational theories behind skills based assessment
- develop competency standards for pass/fail decisions
- develop a skills station based on best practices
- apply skills learnt to one's own practice environment
