

# ASSESSMENT OF PRACTICAL/CLINICAL SKILLS: MULTI-STATION EXAMINATIONS

## Course Description

Developing high quality assessments to evaluate achievements of desired skill sets for future practice is important in medical / health professional educational programmes. This will ensure practice readiness as well as patient safety.

The workshop will explore contemporary best evidence practices in developing multi-station clinical assessment.

The participants will get opportunities to discuss the strengths, limitations and challenges as well as hands-on training developing these clinical skill assessments.

## Workshop Objectives

After this workshop participants will be able to:

- Discuss the underpinning educational theories behind skills-based assessment
- Develop competency standards for pass/fail decisions
- Develop a skills station based on best practices
- Apply skills learnt to one's own practice environment
