## Course Description

Best Evidence Medical Education (BEME) will be applied in all discussions. The course description is posed as questions to provoke participants to reflect on the issues we have raised and also to encourage participants to continue to engage in further discourse with other colleagues, especially after completing this course.

We hope that through this process of sharing and learning together we can build a community of learners and scholars who will contribute to our common mission of delivering effective healthcare to our nation through the education of bright, young and nimble minds.
