Part 1: Sharing on Promoting Inclusivity in Medical Education Publishing

There has been increasing attention to the structural inequities of scholarly publishing across many fields, including medical education. While journals claim to be international, and are due to their readership, their authors tend to be concentrated in five countries: USA, Canada, UK, Netherlands and Australia. This limits our ability to think about problems differently. Increasing diversity in research is important to medical education and health care outcomes by building a community that benefits from the knowledge of all its members. In this talk, I will present a current snapshot of the medical education scholarly publishing landscape including the challenges of diversity and inclusion. I will also share strategies introduced by the journal *Medical Education* to promote equity and greater diversity of authors in the journal.
