The origin of the word portfolio is interesting. It is the combination of two words: 'portare' which means 'to carry' and 'follium' which means 'leaf/sheet'. Portfolio is a portable and a living document that collects personal and professional goals, achievements, and reflections in a systematic manner. In health professions education, portfolio has been introduced as a learning as well as an assessment tool. It is well-document that a portfolio is thought to enhance the assessment of areas that are difficult to assess by traditional methods in a wide range of clinical contexts such as attitudes, personal attributes, reflection and professionalism. However, it is not without its challenges.
