# **Course Description**

Teaching students how to learn using appropriate approaches (large group or small group teaching) has always been a challenge. Large classes should not be limited to lecture-based teaching. Several interactive teaching-learning strategies (also referred to as 'discussion pedagogy') is reviewed as potential strategies for student engagement in their learning. Learning in small groups optimizes, firstly, student engagement in learning, deeper understanding of content knowledge, develops collaborative learning among peers and domain-independent develops also important skills communication, team-work) relevant for future practice. This workshop will discuss various teaching methods and their strengths as well as limitations.

- Discuss how to engage students, motivates them to practice higher order thinking skills and promotes meaningful learning using different small and large groups teaching approaches
- Discuss the strengths of each teaching and learning methods
