This course is to introduce the foundational principles and best practices in managing programs and leading educational development.

- Relate contemporary principles of leadership to one's own educational practice
- Discuss how a leader motivates others to achieve their maximum potential
- Analyse how leadership styles impact on the quality of output and outcome of a task
- Apply sound problem solving and decision-making approaches as a leader in medical education
