Course Description

Humanism is the basic tenet of medicine to provide empathetic patient care. It promotes the development of positive attributes such as honesty and altruism. This allows trainees to have a deeper understanding of patients' beliefs, thoughts and values and also connects trainees with the patients' families, relatives and caregivers. Approaches to developing humanistic qualities in medicine have been studied widely which includes didactic teaching and experiential learning.

This course is designed to develop greater understanding and the necessary skillsets of educators who are involved in mentoring and developing professional identity formation of students as future healthcare professionals.

Workshop Objectives

After this course, participants will be able to:

- Discuss the concept of humanism within the context of health professions education (HPE)
- Discuss the importance of humanism in education, healthcare delivery and healthcare systems
- Describe the challenges in nurturing humanism in HPE
- Describe various strategies for nurturing humanism within HPE
- Apply the concept of humanism to reflective practice
