An educator needs to be proficient in selecting, developing, and implementing commonly used assessment methods in own contexts.

This course is specially designed for medical and health professions educators, leaders and administrative staff who are involved in developing, designing, decision making or providing support to operationalise student/resident assessment.

- Calculate common validity and reliability indices for assessment
- Set pass/fail standard using contemporary best evidence standard setting methods in various contexts
- Carry out post-hoc item analyses and interpret them
