

QUANTITATIVE RESEARCH IN HEALTH PROFESSIONS EDUCATION (HPE)

Course Description

This course aims to provide essential knowledge in quantitative research methodologies in MHPE settings. It also covers data collection and analysis methods. The course will guide participants in how they can decide on a research question(s), select an appropriate quantitative study design, devise data collection tools, collect data, analyse and interpret the data meaningfully, and arrive at rational conclusions.

Workshop Objectives

At the end of the course, participants should be able to:

- Define and describe quantitative research methodologies
- Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of quantitative research methods
- Describe the data collection methods in quantitative research
- Analyse a simple quantitative dataset using appropriate statistical methods
- Design a research project proposal
