

SCHOLARSHIP OF TEACHING AND LEARNING (SoTL) AND RESEARCH IN MEDICAL EDUCATION (RIME)

Course Description

Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) refers to the systematic, evidence-based study of teaching and learning and sharing with the wider community of peer reviewers, with the objective to enhance student learning through strengthened teaching practices. Today, in the 21st century, many institutions of higher learning recognise the scholarship of teaching and learning as a pathway to promotion and tenure in academia.

This course will provide an overview of SoTL and methods to conduct a SoTL project. Educational research methodology will be incorporated in this workshop.

Workshop Objectives

After this workshop participants will be able to:

- Discuss the difference and similarities between SoTL and education research
- Apply a systematic process to develop SoTL
- Discuss different models of evaluating the quality of SoTL
- Apply the theoretical learning to an SoTL project
