

SUPPORTING THE LEARNERS THROUGH SUPERVISION, COACHING AND MENTORING

Course Description

The present medical and health professional training landscape is complex and could be stressful to both the learner and the teacher. As a result, the importance of teachers' proficiency in strategies such as mentoring, supervision and coaching has intensified than ever before. Closely competing for its due place in the teacher's toolkit, these three educational strategies could sometimes be elusively overlapping. This course aims to provide the participants the foundational knowledge and skills in mentoring, supervision and coaching to enhance their own teaching-learning environments.

Workshop Objectives

After this course, participants will be able to:

- Discuss the roles of mentoring, supervision and coaching in the context of present-day health professions education.
- Differentiate the key roles and functions of mentoring, supervision and coaching.
- Identify with justification the role(s)/function(s) in each strategy that would be most suitable to engage in differing teaching and learning situations.
- Discuss the common pitfalls that one should be aware of when applying each of the above three strategies; i.e. mentoring, supervision and coaching.
