## Course Description

The origin of the word portfolio is a combination of two words: 'portare' which means 'to carry' and 'folium' which means 'leaf/sheet'. Portfolio is a portable and a living document that collects personal and professional goals, achievements, and reflections in a systematic manner. In health professions education, portfolio has been introduced as a learning as well as an assessment tool. This course will give a background on portfolio and illustrate how it can be used for assessment as well as the strengths and limitations.

- Differentiate different types of portfolio
- Describe the advantages and challenges in implementing a portfolio
- Design a portfolio to support student learning
- Evaluate a portfolio for assessments
