Course Description

This block empowers educators to integrate scholarship into teaching, transforming routine practices into opportunities for inquiry and dissemination. Through a flipped classroom model, participants explore principles of SoTL, educational research designs, and methodologies. Interactive face-to-face workshops focus on developing and analysing SoTL projects, applying statistical methods, and coding qualitative data, equipping educators to create impactful, evidence-based educational outcomes.
