

## **COLLABORATIVE LEARNING IN SMALL GROUPS**

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### **Aim**

This Workshop will engage participants in:

- a critical review of the teaching-learning process
- identifying the need for a paradigm shift to student-centred learning
- identifying the key elements in ensuring the success of collaborative learning in small groups, including the importance of understanding group dynamics and the impact of tutor facilitation styles

### **Who Should Attend?**

All medical teachers who undertake small group teaching in their own institutions and who need to have a basic understanding of the small group learning process.

### **Pre-requisites**

None. However, this Workshop is recommended for participants who intend to attend the PBL Workshop as it will serve as a useful preparation for better understanding and practice of the PBL process.
