Talk Synopsis:

DIPEx International (https://dipexinternational.org) an association of qualitative and clinical researchers from 14 countries who conduct high quality research on patient experiences and disseminate research findings on publicly accessible websites in addition to scientific conferences and peer-reviewed publications. Health Experiences Singapore—a shared initiative between the Department of Family Medicine, National University Health System and the Centre for Research in Health System Performance (CRiHSP), Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore—is expected to become the 15th member of DIPEx International. This presentation will outline the DIPEx methodology and our plans for our first few research projects under the Health Experiences Singapore banner.
