- All fees quoted above are inclusive of prevailing GST.
- Payment of fees will be on an instalment basis, paid over 2 semesters for full-time students and 4 semesters for part-time students. Full fee must be paid before a student can graduate from the programme.
- Students need to separately pay for the **Miscellaneous Student Fee (MSF)** directly to the University on a semester basis. If a student has fully paid for his/her tuition fee but has yet to graduate, he/she will still need to pay for MSF for the extended semester(s). - Fees are subject to change/inflation.
- Fees paid are not refundable in the event of non-completion of the programme by the candidate.
