1. Application Form

Read the instructions carefully on the webpage before you proceed with the application. Applicants should complete all the sections (i.e. personal particulars, contact, academic qualifications, all the way through the declarations page).

2. Application Fee

Application is complete when the application fee of \$54.50 (including 9% GST) has been made. At the *Payment Due* section, applicants can click on the "*Submit Payment for 54.50 SGD*" tab which will lead to the payment page. Please click on the link only when you are ready to pay.

Do note that your application will only be processed upon receipt of the application fee.

3. Official Transcripts & Degree Certificates

Transcripts of academic work (grades/ marks) in GCE "O" level, GCE "A" Level or equivalent, and diplomas/ degrees/ certificates from each college or university previously attended must be uploaded.

If credentials are not in English, they must be accompanied by a notarized translation.

Please note **ALL** original educational certificates/ transcripts/ degree scroll(s) will need to be furnished for verification when applicant is shortlisted for interview.

4. English Language Proficiency

Applicants from universities where the medium of undergraduate instruction is not in English are required to submit **TOEFL or IELTS scores**. Applicants should have a score of at least 620 for the TOEFL paper-based test or 7.5 for IELTS.

5. Personal Statement

Personal Statement form can be downloaded from the SLP website for completion. Please upload your completed form via the document upload tab in GDA3 system.

6. Referee Report

TWO Referee names, preferably one academic and one employment-related, are to be **assigned** in the GDA3 system, which will trigger notification emails to the respective referees to complete online. Your references should be carefully chosen from university faculty or individuals who have direct knowledge of your (a) academic abilities or work performance, and (b) personal qualities and characteristics. Referees will be given 28 days to submit his/her referee report. **Monitor the GDA3 system to ensure your Referee submits the report within the stipulated deadline in the system.**

7. Documents to upload

At the *Supporting Documents* section, please upload the following documents in **PDF** format:

- Recent passport size photograph;
- Copy of NRIC (local); Passport (International Applicant)
- Goal Statement duly completed;
- ALL** Educational Certificates, Official Transcripts, Degree Scroll(s); and
- Any other document(s) which is/are deemed important for this application.
