Important Notes to Applicants:

- 1. Applicants must read the "Eligibility for sitting the Part 1 & 2 Examinations" before completing this application form. This application form should be typed or written in block letters, please use separate sheets for additional information or explanations if necessary.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure the application form and all required supporting documents reach the Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges (HKICBSC) Secretariat before the deadline. The HKICBSC will not process any INCOMPLETE (including insufficient postage) or LATE application. No allowance will be made for postal or other delays.
- 3. A processing fee **HKD \$450** for Part 1 and **HKD \$475** for Part 2 will be charged respectively for any unsuccessful application, including incomplete application. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria, and to make sure all required documentation and fee are submitted by the required date.

Eligibility of sitting the Part 1 & 2 Examinations

- 4. Applicant should fulfill the following requirements in order to sit for these Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges (HKICBSC) Membership Examinations.
- For local applicants:
 - Having registration with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
- For Mainland China applicants:
 - Must be trainees from Mainland China training centres accredited by the constituent Colleges of HKICBSC (provided that they undergo such training at the time of or after the relevant accreditation)
- Applicant's training should not be suspended within 6 months prior to the examination.
- Basic Surgical Trainees should settle their registration fee of the exam year. Otherwise, they will not be allowed to take the examination.
- The eligibility of sitting the Part 1 & 2 Examinations stated in the Examination Regulations shall prevail in any circumstances.

Supporting Documents

- 5. To enroll in the examination, applicants are required to submit the application form along with **certified true copies** of the following documents to support information given in your application. These copies are not returnable and will be verified in due course.
 - ✓ Certified True Copy of Qualification*:
 - For local applicants:
 - ♦ Basic medical qualification from The University of Hong Kong or The Chinese University of Hong Kong, OR
 - ♦ Letter certifying registrable qualification with the Medical Council of Hong Kong
 - For Mainland China applicants:
 - ♦ Basic medical qualification, which are verified by medical official of Mainland China training centres by the constituent Colleges of HKICBSC, OR a public notary, OR solicitor/lawyer, should have an official stamp accompanying the signature.

(*Copies of letters and certificates will only be accepted if they have been **verified as true copies** by the medical or university official, OR a public notary, OR solicitor/lawyer, should have an official stamp accompanying the signature. The signature (name of verifier should be stated) and hospital stamp must be original.)

- ✓ **Two** certified recent passport photographs with the official stamp and signature by medical or university official;
- 6. Payment method of application fee. Applicants should pay the fee by one of the following methods:
 - A **crossed cheque** or **bank draft** made payable to "<u>The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong LIMITED</u>" in Hong Kong dollars. Please write your name and contact number at the back of the cheque or the bank draft.
 - **Telegraph Transfer**, applicants should notify the College in advance and submit the transaction details along with the application form. An additional amount of **HK\$200** for Bank Administrative Charge is required to be paid by applicants.

Supplementary Note on Application Form for Singapore Applicants

This document serves as a supplementary guide for Singapore applicants applying for the Membership Examinations of the Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges – Part 1 and 2. Its purpose is to clarify the terms and specific requirements for Singapore applicants.

The Division of Graduate Medical Studies, Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore (hereafter referred to as DGMS), is responsible solely for vetting and collecting of application forms and examination fees from applicants. DGMS will submit these to the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong on behalf of applicants. The examination will be conducted in Singapore by our exclusive agent, the British Council.

The College of Surgeons of Hong Kong (hereafter referred to as CSHK), acting as the examination secretariat of the Hong Kong Intercollegiate Board of Surgical Colleges (HKICBSC), reserves the right to accept or reject any application it deems inappropriate.

We strongly encourage all Singapore applicants to carefully review the information provided in the following sections to ensure a smooth and successful application process.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO APPLICANTS (Page 1)

Item No. 2 & 3: It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the application form and all required supporting documents reach **DGMS** before the application deadline. The HKICBSC will not process any INCOMPLETE applications (including insufficient postage) or LATE applications. No allowance will be made for postal or other delays.

A processing fee **HKD \$450** for Part 1 and **HKD \$475** for Part 2 will be charged respectively for any unsuccessful application, including incomplete submissions.

ELIGIBILITY OF SITTING THE PART 1 & 2 EXAMINATIONS (Page 1)

For Singapore applicants:

- Possess a recognised basic medical degree
- Have a valid medical registration with Singapore Medical Council (SMC)
- Have successfully completed their PGY1 or Housemanship









SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS (Page 1)

- * Photocopies of certificates and/or official translations (in English)* including any other official supporting documents will be accepted only if they have been prepared and/or authenticated by one of the following:
 - the issuing University or Medical School;
 - Medical Council of which you are registered and licensed to practice;
 - Ministry of Health, Singapore;
 - a notary public or Justice of the Peace;
 - DGMS For authentication by DGMS office, original certificates and documents must be produced.

^{*}Applicants must submit an authenticated translation if their official supporting documents are not in English. A fresh ink stamp must be used to authenticate the copy or translation of the primary medical qualification.

The following are examination fees for Singapore applicants:

- Part 1: SGD \$1,600 (This includes the concessional examination fees charged by CSHK: HKD 5,760, along with the administrative fees charged by DGMS and GST at 9%.)
- Part 2: SGD \$1,700
 (This includes the concessional examination fees charged by CSHK: HKD 6,080, along with the administrative fees charged by DGMS and GST at 9%.)

Notes:

- An application fee of SGD \$87.20 must be paid at the time of application and is non-refundable.
- All fees are inclusive of the prevailing GST and are subject to changes without prior notice

• MCHK registration number or LMCHK number (please quote year obtained) – Singapore applicants should instead provide the Medical Council Registration (MCR) number from the Singapore Medical Council and the year obtained.

SECTION 3 - CHECKLIST (Page 5)

- **Item No. 3:** Full examination fee to DGMS in Singapore dollars.
- **Item No. 4:** The requirement to pay the Basic Surgical Trainee registration fee for the exam year, as well as any outstanding fees, applies only to Basic Surgical Trainees in Hong Kong.
- Item No. 6: Certified True Copy of practising certificate from Singapore Medical Council (SMC).
- **Item No. 8:** DGMS will send the applications to the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong on behalf of the applicants. Please ensure all required supporting documents reach **DGMS** before the application deadline.

SECTION 5 - RELEASE INFORMATION and RESULTS (Page 6)

- Results are typically released approximately 6 to 8 weeks after the examination concludes.
- The results letter will be sent via courier to each Singaporean candidate. Candidates will also be notified via email of the dispatch date for their results letter.
- If the results letter is not received by the specified deadline, candidates must contact the CSHK secretariat. Please note that a fee will be charged for re-issuance after the deadline.
- By signing this section, Singapore applicants explicitly agree to the release of their examination results to DGMS.

The examination fee must be paid through DGMS via the Online System for Course Applications (OSCA) system.
