5	Copy of Degree Certificate (for applicants who have graduated from undergraduate studies) or Official Student Status Letter from university (for applicants who have yet to graduate at time of application)	
6	Copy of Official University Transcript (for applicants who have graduated from undergraduate studies) or Latest Unofficial Transcript (for applicants who have yet to graduate at time of application)	
7	Copy of Professional/Specialist Certificate(s) for the qualifications stated in the online application form	
8	Copy of TOEFL / IELTS Scoresheet (only applicable for applicants whose native tongue or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English)	
9	Documentary Proof of Financial Support e.g. bank statement, recent payslip, certificate of deposit or original sponsor's letter. The financial proof should certify the applicant's financial ability to make payment for tuition and miscellaneous student fees and living expenses of S\$18,000 per year throughout the normal duration of MSc programme	
10	Assign AT LEAST ONE (1) referee under "Referee" section of the online application portal. Your referee(s) will receive an email with instructions to submit their reference directly. DO NOT upload any reference letter to the portal.
