Coursework Requirements and implications for PGF and GSA students

With effect from AY2024-25 Semester 1 (i.e. from August 2024), standardized rules were introduced for President's Graduate Fellowship (PGF) students who do not meet the coursework requirements. These standard rules will also be applicable for the NUSMed GSA recipients.

- (i) You will receive a "reminder" if you do not enrol for at least one graded course and maintain an average grade of B+ and above in your first semester.
- (ii) You will receive a "warning" and your PGF / GSA will be suspended in the following semester if you still have not enrolled in a graded course or fail to maintain an average grade of B+ in your second semester.
- (iii) Your PGF/GSA will be terminated if you continue to take courses on S/U basis or fail to maintain an average grade of B+ by the third semester.

All premium scholarship students are hence strongly encouraged to enroll in <u>at least one</u> <u>course on a graded basis during their first semester</u>.
