2	Statement of Intent (not more than 300 words) A focused academic and professional summary detailing your motivation for applying to the MSc Medical Pharmacology programme, your relevant background, and how the programme aligns with your career goals.	
3	Personal Statement A reflective narrative highlighting your personal journey, values, and experiences that have shaped your interest in pharmacology, including any challenges overcome and qualities you bring to the programme.	
4	Curriculum Vitae (CV) detailing relevant experience, skills, qualifications and accomplishments.	
5	Copy of Degree Certificate (for applicants who have graduated from undergraduate studies) or; Official Student Status Letter from university (for applicants who have yet to graduate at time of application)	
6	Copy of Official University Transcript (applicants may submit the latest unofficial transcript if they have yet to graduate at time of application)	
7	Copy of TOEFL / IELTS Scoresheet (for applicants whose native tongue or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English)	
8	Copy of Passport (for international applicants) or NRIC (for local applicants)
