

He continues to contribute significantly to education, actively supporting the Advanced Internal Medicine Exit examination as a chief examiner for senior residency exit examinations, besides playing a vital role in contributing to MRCP/MMED examinations.

A/Prof Lee has been instrumental in developing every aspect of renal care at the Division of Nephrology, including Peritoneal Dialysis, Haemodialysis, Kidney transplantation, Glomerulonephritis and Chronic Kidney Disease Care. He has led and set up NUH's haemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis services, in addition to the first outpatient high-dependency haemodialysis programme in Singapore, which took care of the highest-risk kidney failure cases with dialysis-related hypotension and cardiac diseases. It is also notable that he has gone beyond medical to train nursing and allied health students, which shows his vision of education to serve the multidisciplinary demands of today's healthcare.
