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## Guidelines for Channel

### A. Branding & Style

1. **Clarity:** To optimise learning, aim to deliver content clearly and concisely.
2. **Relevance:** Focus on educational content directly related to the medical undergraduate curriculum.
3. **For NUS Contributors on Branding:** As far as possible, all videos should bear the horizontal coloured School logo at the top right-hand corner. This will serve as an identifier on your material and help to prevent unauthorised copying/ editing. Please refer to NUS Corporate Identity guidelines for co- branding with NUS logo: <https://www.nus.edu.sg/identity/guidelines/co-branding-with-nus-logo#applications>
4. **For External Contributors on Attribution:**
  - Clearly identify your institutional affiliation or professional credentials
  - Include appropriate disclaimers about content scope and limitations

- Ensure content respects copyright and intellectual property rights
- Provide clear learning objectives for each video

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## B. Content Accessibility

1. Language: Use clear, internationally understood English. Define technical terms and avoid region-specific references without explanation.
2. Cultural Sensitivity: Ensure content is respectful of diverse cultural backgrounds and healthcare systems.
3. Scope Clarity: Clearly indicate if the content is specific to healthcare systems, regulations, or practices.
4. Prerequisites: State any required background knowledge or intended audience level.

## Technical Requirements



1. Naming convention: **[CreatorName]-[Title\_of\_Video/Image].mp4/jpg**
2. Videos
  1. Resolution:
    1. 1080p (1920 x 1080 pixels) **(Recommended)**
    2. Widescreen aspect ratio at 16:9, high-definition (HD)
  2. Acceptable format: **MP4**, codec H.264



3. Progressive scan / non-interlaced scanning
4. Recommended framerate: 25/30/50 frames per seconds (fps)
3. Visuals on YouTube may vary slightly due to different device screen settings, the lighting in your surrounding location, and other technical factors.
4. Additional Requirements for All Contributors:
  - Ensure **proper acknowledgment and attribution** of resources in the video.
  - Provide a **brief video description** (100-200 words) outlining learning objectives
  - Include **relevant tags** for searchability (medical specialty, topic area, difficulty level)"
  - **Resource thumbnail:** Provide an image (jpg, 1920x1080px recommended) with a short description up to 20 words.
