Overview

The Master of Nursing (MN) curriculum offered by NUS reflects the current healthcare needs and the importance of advanced nursing practice.

Students receive advanced clinical knowledge, skills and acquired professional attitude from a range of disciplines in advanced nursing practice, clinical medicine, social sciences and public health. Students acquire and apply learnt knowledge and skills not only on campus but also in clinical practice settings.

Upon successful completion of the MN programme, graduates are eligible to apply for APN provisional license with the Singapore Nursing Board (SNB) to continue with a 12-month Integrated APN Internship (IAI).

Admission

One intake in January every academic year.

Online Application Period: 1 Sept to 15 Oct every year.

- Bachelor's degree in Nursing from a SNB accredited programme*;
- Min GPA of 3.20;
- TOEFL 580/237/85 or IELTS 6.5 or equivalent – for applicants whose native tongue or medium of undergraduate education is not in English;
- Full registration and valid Practicing Certificate with the SNB;
- At least 5 years continuous clinical practice as a Registered Nurse;
- Advanced Diploma/Post-graduate Diploma in a Clinical Specialty for acute care (Critical Care & Emergency) and Mental Healthcare applicants;
- Strong recommendation from Chief Nurse, Director of Nursing and Head of respective department;
- Meet the health requirements stipulated by the Ministry of Health Singapore.
