Advanced Placement Credits	<p>Applicants who have completed an Advanced Diploma in Critical Care Nursing from Nanyang Polytechnic or Ngee Ann Polytechnic, or the National University Hospital's Critical Care Programme within the last 8 years (prior to the date of admission to the University) and have successfully passed the placement test will be granted credits for NUR5721 Foundations of Critical Care Nursing, NUR5722 Multisystem Nursing Practice I and NUR5723 Multisystem Nursing Practice II.</p>
