Entry Requirements

MMed (O&G) or MRCOG or equivalent

Duration of the entire training programme

6 months to 1 year

Objectives of the training programme

- i. Manage outpatient urogynaecology patients, e.g. overactive bladder, dry and wet, stress urinary incontinence, mixed incontinence, voiding difficulty, urinary tract infection (UTI), recurrent UTIs, painful bladder syndrome, pelvic organ prolapse, dysparenia.
- ii. Perform and interpret urodynamic investigations: filling and voiding cystometry valsalva leak point pressure
- iii. Observe, assist and operate under supervision (Please note that priority to assist or operate will be given to the department's trainees)
 - a. Mid-urethral tape: retropubic and obturator McCall Coldoplasty and
 - b. Vaginal hysterectomy with McCall culdoplasty and bilateral salpingooophorectomy, pelvic floor repair
 - c. Manchester repair
 - d. Saccrospinous ligament fixation
 - e. Conventional and vaginal cystocoele and rectocoele repair
 - f. Vaginal cystocoele and rectocoele repair using Prosima or Prolift mesh
 - g. Abdominal Sacrocolpopexy
- iv. Management of post-op patients in in-patient ward, especially acute urinary retention
