

**APPLICATION FOR DATA FROM THE GERONTOLOGY RESEARCH PROGRAMME**

The following general conditions concern the applicant/co-applicants (hereafter called “the Applicant”) and the Principal Investigator for GRP for withdrawal of data from the GRP database.

The Applicant understands and accepts the following conditions for withdrawal of data (hereafter called “the Dataset”) from the GRP database. The dataset refers to any data that are collected within the GRP, during the baseline and later follow ups.

- The Applicant is only allowed to use the Dataset for the purpose that is mentioned in the “Information about the Research project”.
- The Applicant agrees not to give the Dataset away to any other person.
- For projects that could have commercial significance, special agreement should be made with the Principal Investigator of GRP and the Applicant if there are no reservations stated in this application.
- The Applicant must safeguard the confidentiality and privacy of the dataset and it should be stored in a way that no unauthorized person can take/access all or part of it.
- The Applicant agrees to erase the Dataset and any copies of it when the research project is completed, and then inform the Data Manager and the Principal Investigator for GRP that this is done.
- The Applicant cannot collect further information from the participants in the population study or their relatives without special written approval from the Principal Investigator of GRP.
- The Applicant must avoid any form of conflicts of interest, whether actual or potential. Where such conflict arises, the Applicant has a duty to make a declaration to give full disclosure of the facts and to detail the steps proposed or taken to avoid it.
- For publications and conference presentations, the Applicant must acknowledge the GRP contributions, and the final manuscript should be given to the archivist responsible.
- The Applicant does not have the right to transfer his/her rights and obligations without prior approval in writing from the Principal Investigator of GRP.
