<u>PART A: BEFORE THE SJT BEGINS</u>	
Assessment Rules:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Do not record this assessment in part or in whole, in any format.2. The assessment is confidential; it must not be stored or transmitted in any way.3. This assessment must be taken individually without the help of any other person(s) or device.4. Ensure that you have your NRIC/SAF 11B (Singaporeans and Permanent Residents) or passport (International applicants) with you for verification before starting the assessment.5. If your identification does not match your application, you will not be able to proceed with the assessment. <p>If you are caught cheating or flouting any of the above-mentioned rules, you will be subject to severe penalties. These penalties include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your application to any course in NUS will be void.• Expulsion from any course in NUS if found out after matriculation.
Interview location:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Please ensure that you are in an enclosed room with only one entry point throughout the entire assessment.2. The room should also be quiet and free from external distractions so that you may hear the questions asked and similarly, have your responses heard clearly.3. You should be the ONLY person in the room.
Device requirements:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Only use a laptop or desktop.2. The computer/laptop that you are using must not be connected to an external display/devices. You should not have any monitors or screens beside you.3. Please ensure that the microphone and speakers are working and <u>not muted</u>. You may use ear/headphones if you wish to do so.4. Your device camera must be able to capture you clearly from your shoulders upwards.5. You will be required to do a 360 scan of your room using your device's camera.6. During your assessment, you will be expected to read text on the screen. Ensure that your device is sufficiently powered throughout the assessment.

<p>Proview administered assessments require desktops or PCs which meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Operating System: Windows (Vista and above), Linux (Any), OS X (10. 6 +) or macOS Sierra and above, and BSD (4 +)• Based Applications: Proview is a fully web-based technology and only supports integration with browser-based applications• Browser Support: The latest versions of the following modern browsers: Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome latest version• HTTPS Over SSL: Proview is served over fully end-to-end encrypted secure connections and uses HTML5/WebRTC which requires HTTPS connections. Service providers integrating Proview are also required to have fully encrypted SSL connections for complete security <p>To run Proview on a desktop or a PC, the system must have the following hardware:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. RAM – 256 MB or above for desktops and laptops and 1GB or above for notebooks2. Graphics – Minimum of 64 MB of graphics memory (internal/external)3. Multimedia support – Sound card4. Microphone (standard 3.5 mm jack/internal) – Use of mobile microphones is not recommended5. Webcam – Supporting minimum 320 x 240 that records color videos at 15 fps6. Internet speed – Minimum internet speed required per user upload speed: 1 Mbp download speed: 1 Mbps7. Internet speed – Recommended internet speed for each user upload speed: 2 Mbps download speed: 2 Mbps8. Processor – 1 GHz or faster x86-compatible processor, or Intel® Atom™ 1.6GHz or faster processor for Netbooks
