Attached to Staff Health and Wellbeing Clinics for observations in NUH. 2. Attached to Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health and NUS Office of Risk Management and Compliance to observe the spectrum of occupational health work performed. 3. Sit into Specialist Outpatient Clinics (SOC) with Occupational Medicine Specialists, for exposure to the spectrum of Occupational Medicine cases seen in the hospitals (e.g. SKH, SGH, TTSH) and private sectors. 4. Sit in the weekly teachings by the National Preventive Medicine Residency Programme. 5. Tag along workplace inspections and visits within the hospitals and industries for observations when available.
