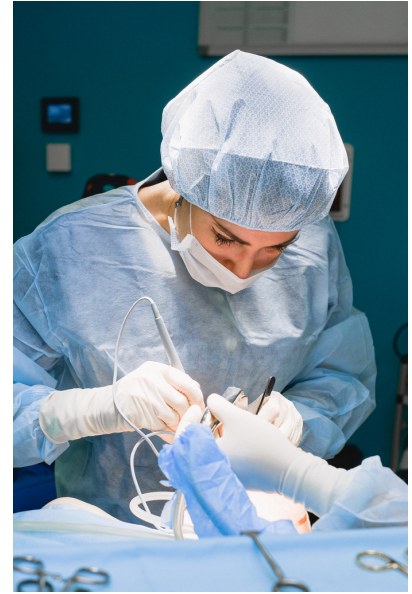
Why Attend
