

MINOR IN INTEGRATIVE HEALTH (MIH) FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is the availability of the Minor in Integrative Health (MIH) and its courses?

MIH is an open Minor programme available to all undergraduate students except those enrolled in Medicine and Dentistry. MIH consists of exactly 5 courses and students will need to complete all **5** courses (20 units in total) to graduate with the Minor.

*If students have no fulfilled any prerequisites to read MIH2201, they may enrol into MIH2201 on the condition that they also enrolled in MIH1102 in the **same** semester.

2. Is it mandatory to complete MIH1101 first before proceeding to MIH1102?

No. MIH1101 and MIH1102 are meant to be entry points for students to embark on MIH. Students may complete MIH1102 first before proceeding to MIH1101.

3. If I have no intention to complete all 5 courses for the Minor, can I read the courses individually?

Yes, students can read MIH course(s) as Unrestricted Electives (UE) as long as they fulfil the required course prerequisites (if any).

4. How can I declare a Minor in Integrative Health (MIH)?

As MIH is an open Minor programme, prior approval is not required. Students can declare their intention during the Academic Plan Declaration exercise for a given semester (<https://nus.edu.sg/coursereg/academic-plan-application-declaration.html>) no later than the end of their fifth semester of study.

5. How do I drop the Minor in Integrative Health (MIH)?

Students may drop the MIH via the Academic Plan Declaration exercise (<https://nus.edu.sg/coursereg/academic-plan-application-declaration.html>). No prior approval is required.

6. If the Minor in Integrative Health (MIH) is dropped from my academic plan, what would happen to the MIH courses that I have completed?

The MIH courses which you had completed may be used to satisfy the Unrestricted Electives (UE) requirements.

7. What is the duration of the Minor in Integrative Health (MIH)?

At its quickest, students may complete MIH within 3 semesters, subject to their schedule and workload. On average however, students could take 4-5 semesters (~2 years).

8. Are MIH courses mappable to overseas exchange courses?

No. MIH courses are not applicable for mapping to overseas exchange courses.

9. Can Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) option be applied to MIH courses?

10. Do the courses under the Minor in Integrative Health (MIH) have final exams?

Nope. All MIH courses are fully continuous assessment (CA).
